The Fair Housing Project (FHP) of NH Legal Assistance, a statewide non-profit law firm providing civil legal services to low-income New Hampshire residents, will be holding a training for area people to become involved in this work as **fair housing testers**.

Testers are individuals who are trained to act as prospective tenants seeking rental housing and to gather information on possible housing discrimination.

Being involved in the testing program is also a way to learn new skills, meet interesting people, and work on an exciting civil rights project. Testers receive a flat fee of \$75 for the training once a practice test is completed, and \$16/hr. afterwards. Testers are independent contractors, participate in 2-4 tests a year and are critical to ending housing discrimination.
